

Research Topics

You must choose 3 topics to research that are related to your project. You should write a research summary of approximately 1 page for each topic. You may use one interview as a research topic. The interview should have at least 10 questions and answers and have the name, contact information and credentials of the person you interviewed.

Reflection Essay

1st paragraph: why/how you chose your project (include any changes you made),

2nd paragraph: introduce your community mentor, how you chose that mentor, and how your mentor helped you,

3rd paragraph: introduce what you did for your project,

4th paragraph: introduce and explain your research topics

5th paragraph: an analysis and reflection of your project and your future (is this the job you want? Why or why not?)

Use 12 point Times New Roman font double spaced and 1 inch margins.

Keynote Presentation

You must have at least 15 slides:

5 on what you did

5 on your research

5 on analysis, reflections, and conclusions.

You may have more than 15 slides, but your presentation can be no longer than 15 minutes.

Use bullet points and visuals to create your Keynote. DO NOT read from your slides! It's soooooo boring! Create note cards and use your Keynote as a guide for your presentation.

Binder Organization

You need a three-ring binder to keep all of your forms, papers, and drafts organized. It should be in this order: 1) your rubric; 2) forms (parent/student agreement, proposal, community mentor agreement, hours log); 3) your research summaries; 4) one copy of your essay; 5) essay rough drafts with teacher comments or corrections.
