CHOOSING YOUR COURSES FOR NEXT YEAR

Google Form

- You will select your Career Cluster
- Option for PE
- You will select five electives
- Changed your mind? Resubmit the form. Entries are time-stamped and the most recent form will be used, others will be deleted.

YOUR CAREER CLUSTER

- You should have completed an assessment to help you determine your Career Cluster.
- You should select electives that fit into your Career Cluster.
- Information on Career Clusters is posted on the PVHS website.

CORE CLASSES

- English – Your current English teacher will talk with you to help you decide between regular English 9 and Honors English 9.
- Math – All freshmen take double-blocked Algebra I. If you are currently taking Algebra I, you will be registered for Geometry 9, which is the geometry class for freshmen.
- Science – Your current science teacher will talk to you and help you decide between Regular Biology, or Honors Biology.
- Social Studies – All freshmen take New Mexico History and Health. You will take one of those classes in the fall, and the other one in the spring. These are the only classes that will change after Christmas.

SPORTS AND PERFORMING GROUPS

- Students who are planning on participating in a sport can take the 7th hour sports class and/or the sports weightlifting class. The coach will let us know which classes to put the athletes in for next year. You are not able to select a 7th hour sports class or the sport-specific weightlifting class.
- If you are interested in trying out for a performing group that requires an audition, such as choir or orchestra, be sure to select the one you are interested in as your first choice. The director will get in contact with you regarding auditions, if required.

CHOOSING ELECTIVES

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- PE classes can be taken each year for your enjoyment and for support in maintaining a healthy lifestyle.
- We offer Personal Fitness and Weightlifting.
- Lifetime Activities can be taken during your junior or senior year.

PE GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

In addition to taking a PE or sports class, the PE graduation requirement can also be met by:

- 3 complete seasons of a sport
- 3 complete seasons of an activity
- 2 semesters of Marching Band
- 1 year of JROTC

FOREIGN LANGUAGE GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

- One credit of a foreign language is required for graduation.
- This graduation requirement can also be met by a Career Cluster class. Most of our electives are career cluster classes.
- However, we recommend students to take two years of the same foreign language, especially students who are planning on attending a four-year university.
- We offer French and Spanish.
- You must pass your English class this semester with a C or higher to take a foreign language class.
- Students who complete FOUR years of the same foreign language and score high enough on an assessment such as an AP test, can earn the Bilingual Seal.

NAVAJO AND SPANISH BILINGUAL CLASSES









- If you are currently in a bilingual class for Spanish or Navajo, you will not be able to select those classes.
- If you will continue in that program, we will automatically register you for the correct bilingual language class.
- Students in the bilingual program are definitely eligible for the Bilingual Seal in their language!

RELIGION RELEASE

- If you will be having a class period off from PV in order to take Seminary through your church, you will have Religion Release either 1st or 7th hour.
- You are not able to select this as an elective.
- We will get the list of Seminary students from the church and will add Religion Release to those students' schedules.

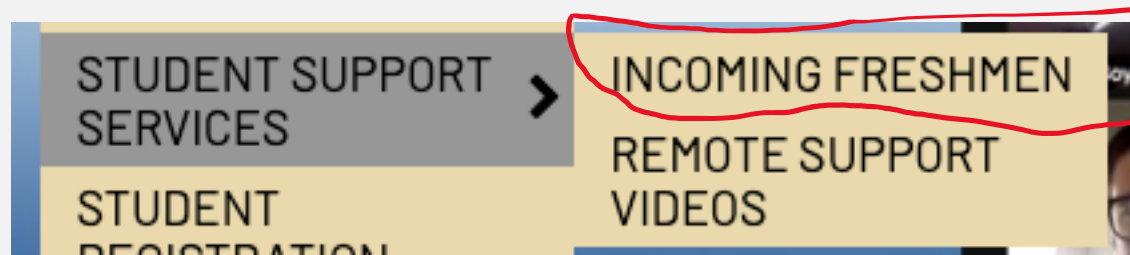
You should complete the Google form that is now in Schoology with your course requests by March 12, 2021, the day we get out for Spring Break.
